

How to Sign up for State Health

To change or confirm your health plan selection for next year, you need to login to the State Health site during open enrollment (10/16/17-11/3/17). When you finish, be sure to print out a confirmation statement – it will show your health care selection and your confirmation number.



- 1 Go to the State Health website: www.myshbpga.adp.com (Click Register and follow the instructions if this is your first time logging in. Use SHBP-GA as the registration code)
- 2 Login using your user name and password, then click “Continue” under the OE window.
- 3 Review the Terms and Conditions, then click “Accept Terms and Conditions.”
- 4 Click on “Go to Review Your Current Elections.”
- 5 Click on “Go To Review Your Dependents.” Make sure their names and SSNs match their social security card exactly. To add additional dependents, make sure you have their SSN handy! Click on “Add a Dependent.” Scroll down and check the “Include in Coverage” box located next to the newly added dependent. Remember, you may cover children until they are 26 years old.
- 6 Click on “Go to Make your Elections.”
- 7 Click on “Go To Tobacco Surcharge question.” You MUST answer the Tobacco Surcharge question using the radial buttons. Remember that if you or one of the dependents you plan to cover is a tobacco user, there is an \$80 per month surcharge added to your plan cost.
- 8 Decline or accept the opportunity to use the Decision Support Benefit Option Comparison Tool.
- 9 Click on “Go to Health Benefits”
- 10 Make your plan selection for 2018.
- 11 Click on “Go to Review and Confirm Changes.”
- 12 **IMPORTANT**—Click FINISH when you’re done and get a confirmation statement with a confirmation number—it’s the only way to prove that you meant to choose your plan!

Adding Dependents?

If you are adding a spouse or children to your State Health plan, you must provide documentation to State Health, like birth certificates. Look for the letter from State Health requesting these documents and respond quickly. Failure to turn in the documents by the deadline will result in coverage cancellation for your dependents even though you will pay the premium!
