Your child may be eligible to receive Supplemental Educational Services (SES), which is **free tutoring** provided by State approved providers.

*If you would like to request SES (free tutoring) for your child, please complete the attached Request for Services Form and return it no later than **February 3, 2012**.*

Also attached are the answers to some frequently asked questions about Supplemental Educational Services (SES) and a list of State approved providers who serve our district as well as a short description of each to assist you with choosing a provider to serve your child. A list of GaDOE State approved providers is also available at your child's school, at the district office, and on the district website: www.barrow.k12.ga.us.

Each child is allotted \$1158 for tutoring. This money will be paid directly to the tutoring company or provider by the school district on behalf of the participating student and at no charge to the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) once tutoring has taken place.

If the school district does not have sufficient funds to provide services to all eligible children, priority will be given to children eligible to receive free or reduced price meals and with the lowest academic achievement.
