Why are math standards so important?

The Math standards are important because they help ensure that all students K-12 are prepared for success in college and the workforce. Standards provide a clear road map for learning for teachers, parents, and students.




- Demonstrate and explain the relationship between numbers and quantities up to 20
- Count forward and backward within 100
- Break numbers 11-19 apart into tens and ones
- Compare numbers up to 20
- · Add and subtract within 10
- Create repeating patterns
- Analyze simple graphs to answer questions
- Identify and describe 2-D shapes and 3-D figures
- Identify coins and their values (pennies, nickels, dimes)
- Classify and sort up to 10 objects by attributes

How can I help my student?

There are several ways that you can help your student be successful in Math:

- Encourage your student to attend school each day so there are no interruptions in the Math learning process.
- Provide a quiet area for your student that is free of distractions such as cell phones, televisions, and other devices to work on Math.
- Sit down with your student at least once a week and ask what your student is learning about in Math. Have your student teach you the Math.
- Apply Math to real-life situations (ex-sports) and use real objects to do Math.
- Play Math games (ex-board games) and make Math fun.
- · Use Math when you cook and bake with your student.
