Please think about your electives and career paths you may be interested in so your counselor may better help match electives to your interests and goals.

If you have a copy of your grades, transcript and/or schedule from your previous school, please provide this to your counselor to help guide their decisions in the courses you need, especially graduation requirements.

IF YOU ARE JOINING US MID-SEMESTER: Apalachee is on a BLOCK Schedule. What is a block schedule? AHS students take 4 semester-long classes per semester with the exception of a few classes. AHS students receive one full credit per course in December and May if they pass their classes. If you are coming from a block-schedule school, counselors will do their best to match this schedule.

What if your school has a non-block/traditional schedule?

A traditional schedule has year-long classes. Traditional schools typically have 7 or 8 classes per day and students receive a half-credit in December and May per class that they pass (equaling one credit at the end of the year). If this is

your situation, you may have to Audit your classes at Apalachee High School. Please contact your counselor for options if you are in this situation.
