

## **Demographic Cross-Comparisons (ES)**

The rezone committee considered several criteria when selecting the elementary school attendance zones. The below charts provide more insight and data for these three criteria:

- Balance of enrollment across schools
- Consideration of expected future growth
- Title I/Social Economic Status balance

## Enrollment

Using current enrollment data from this school year (2022-2023), the below chart shows what the enrollment would look like now if the selected zone were currently in place.

The SY24 (school year 2023-2024) shows the projected enrollment for next year. It takes into consideration student progression to the next grade level with a 3% growth rate.

**Key takeaway**: This chart shows that this rezone option has a balanced distribution of students among the AHS elementary schools.

## Free & Reduced Lunch Percentage

Using current free and reduced lunch data from this school year (2022-2023), the below chart shows what the percentages by school would look like now if the selected zone were currently in place.
