For freshman year the following are required: Algebra (Geometry, if you are currently in Algebra), World Geography, 9th Grade Literature, Earth Systems (Biology, if you are currently in Physical Science), and Health/PE (or equivalent). If your student intends on going to a 4-year post-secondary institution, 2 units of the same modern language are usually required for admissions.
